Purpose

The primary purpose of this role is to maintain the Network and Security, providing support to the production environment and ensuring that the right Network and security policies\ practices are implemented and enforce across the group.

Specific Responsibilities

- Designing, implementing and maintaining enterprise network infrastructure, including, but not limited to, WAN, LAN, SD-WAN, Firewalls, VPNs and wireless networks.
- Vulnerability management of any network related software, routers, switches, intrusion detection or intrusion prevention, physical and virtual firewalls also cryptography systems.
- Assist with development and enforcement of security policies and procedures to protect company assets.
- Maintenance, and administration of the business enterprise network infrastructure and securityrelated hardware and software.
- Responsible for quarterly vulnerability assessment testing and annual penetration testing, lead remediation and actions\ projects.
- Assist in the development and maintenance of disaster recovery and business continuity plans.
- Ensure network security best practices are executed through auditing: router, change control, switch, firewall configurations, and monitoring
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to support network and security requirements for various projects.
- Monitor network performance and troubleshoot issues to ensure optimal functionality and security.
- Troubleshooting network problems and outages, scheduling upgrades including service packs, patches, hot fixes and security configurations.
- Reviewing system changes for security implications and recommending improvements.
- Provide technical support and training to internal staff as needed.
- Maintain up-to-date knowledge of emerging threats and industry best practices.
- Liaise with 3rd party vendors and other IT personnel for problem resolution.
